	25 th Led by:  Macmillan cancer	Social Moral Mutual respect and tolerance	To develop an awareness of how we can support others and show respect.	Free



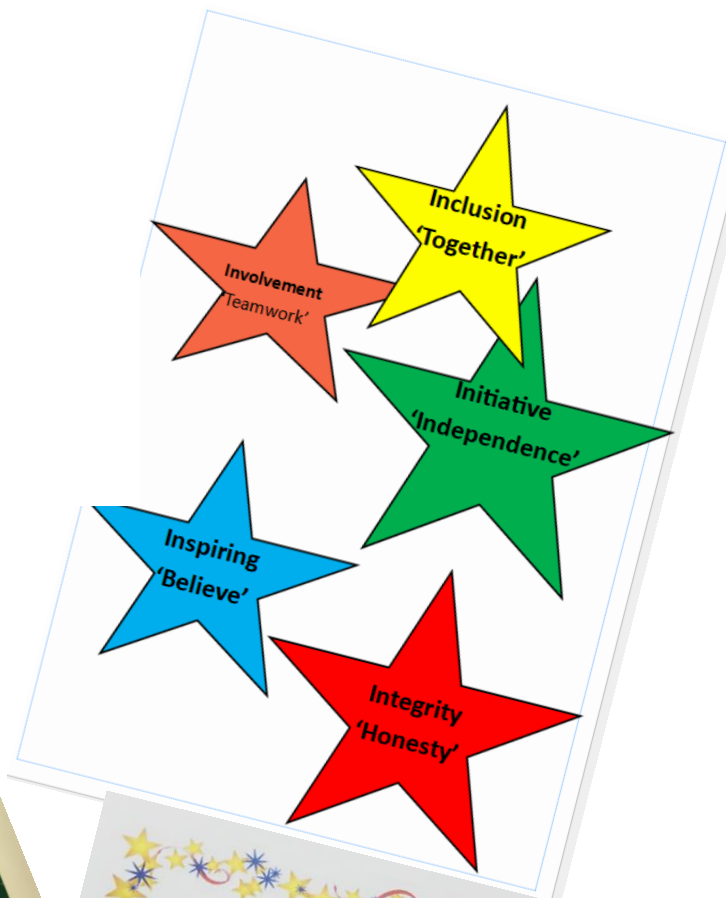
Spiritual Development

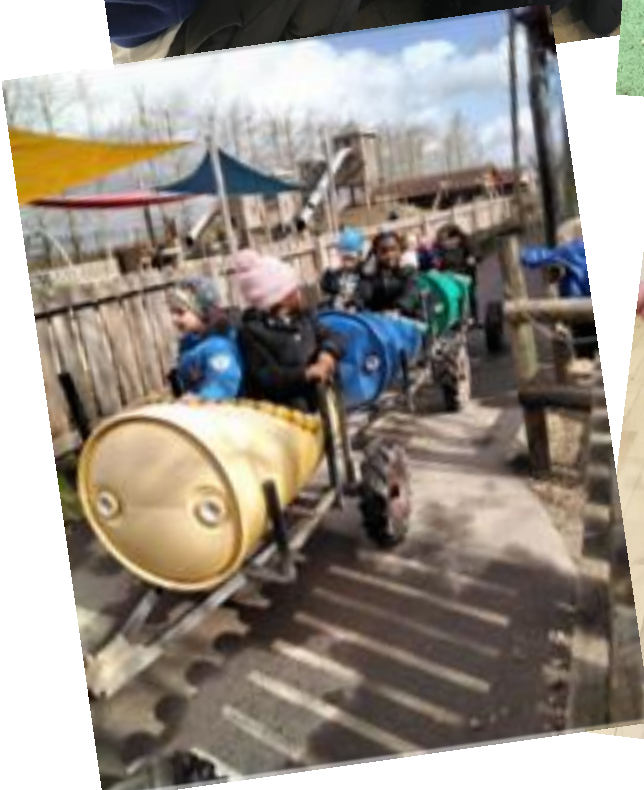
