Attendance



Arriving at school on time every school day is crucial.

Children in Reception need to be in school by 9am and finish school at 3.10pm. Children in Years 1 & 2 need to be in by 8.50am and finish their school day at 3pm.

Children must be collected promptly. It is also very important to call the office **every morning** that your child is absent. Please leave a message with your child's name, class and reason why your child will not be in.

If we are unable to reach a parent/carer by 12pm we may carry out a home visit. This is integral to our Safeguarding and Attendance Policy.





Uniform



Uniform at KPIA is as follows:

White polo shirt, grey trousers or skirts, Royal blue cardigans or sweatshirts, with white or grey socks and black shoes. Please ensure students wear the KPIA jumpers not KPJA jumpers.

PE kit should consist of a plain white t-shirt and tracksuit bottoms and PE trainers or black pumps. PE kit will remain in school until the end of the term and can then be collected to be washed. .

Please can we ask that children come into school with their hair tied up and with no jewellery. A small pair of stud earrings can be worn but must be removed on PE or club days.

Reception had a fantastic day at the farm. They really enjoyed the ride on the coach.



Online Safety



With children increasingly exposed to digital media and online technology at an early age, parents play an important role in keeping children safe online. Here are some tips to help you get started.

HOW TO KEEP YOUR KIDS SAFE ON THE INTERNET





Be aware of what your kids are looking at online. Even child friendly sites



Follow your child on any social media platform so you can see what they are exposed to



Get to know the social media platforms and what they are mainly used for.



Teach your children not to share any personal information or photos online at any time.



Know what sites your kids are on and sit with them when they are online to get a feel for the content.



Make them aware of cyber bullying and let them know to always come to you if someone is not nice to them on social media.



Regulate the amount of time kids are online outside of school requirements.











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Ensure they never reply to a message or email from a stranger or upload any photos of people/your home.



Apply parental controls where possible, but don't trust that they will catch all inappropriate content.

We were so impressed with the Easter Bonnets today, thank you for supporting your child to complete this. We had great fun in our parade.








