

Hello Year 1 families. Detailed below is some of the learning that will be taking place in Year 1 this term.

English - Writing

In our English lessons this term, the Children will be completing fiction writing based on the story of 'The Queen's Hat'. We will be continuing to write using capital letters for names and at the start of a sentence, using 'Fred' to help us to spell words. We will be learning lots of new fabulous words to make our writing wonderful to read and extending our writing by adding more!



We will also be writing independently about science workshop, describing what happened and what we did.

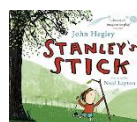


We will also be continuing to develop our handwriting, writing from left to right, forming letters correctly, and of course writing on the line. If you would like any practice sheet to practice at home, please let a member of staff know.

English - Reading

For our reading this term, we will be making predictions about stories, decoding longer words using phonic knowledge, and using pictures to make inferences about what might be happening or what might happen next. The children will also be continuing to sequence stories.



Maths

In our maths this term we will be moving on to working with numbers to 50. We will be counting to 50, writing numbers to 50, counting by making groups of 10, and finding one more and one less.

We will also be learning about comparing length and height, measuring length using cubes and rulers, and solving word problems.



The children will think about length and capacity. Within this, what is heavier and lighter, measure and compare mass, consider full and empty, and solve word problems about mass and capacity.

Science

This term we will be learning about plants. We will be comparing seeds and bulbs, observing the growth of a sunflower, and naming the parts of a plant. We will have lots of hands on experiences looking and plants.

We will be looking and wild and garden plants, and observing trees that are evergreen and deciduous.



History

This term we will be thinking about the achievements of Neil Armstrong. We will be understanding what makes him a 'significant person' in history. We will learn about his adventure to the moon and the exciting things he said.



RE

This term, we will be thinking about the Easter story within Christianity. We will be learning about how the people welcomed Jesus and why the people welcomed them in that way. We will be learning the story and understanding the importance of this story to Christians. We will be using the Bible and videos to support our learning. We will continue this learning by learning about the other ways we see new life at this time.



Art



This term we will be looking at the work of the famous artist Paul Klee. We will use chalk, pencils and pens to draw different lines and marks before considering how Paul Klee used different lines to create his own art. We will 'take a dot for a walk' and create our own, Paul Klee inspired piece of artwork.
