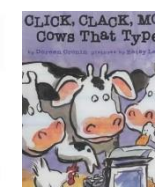
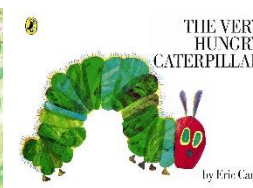
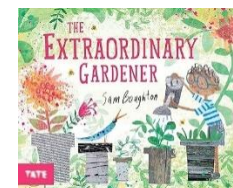
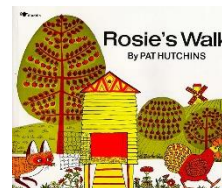


EYFS Newsletter Spring 2

Naming and properties of 3D shapes

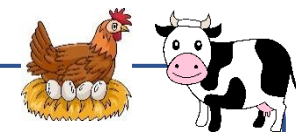
UTW - RE

The children will be learning about the different signs of Spring and will be learning about the Easter Story.



UTW - SCIENCE

The children will be learning about animals that live on the farm and will be learning about where food such as eggs and milk come from. We will also be exploring the life cycle of a chicken and also the life cycle of a butterfly. The children will also be exploring seasonal changes and compare winter to Spring.



COMMUNICATION & LANGUAGE

The children will be learning new and exciting vocabulary through our writing sessions with Grandma Fantastic and we will be focusing on the stories: Extraordinary Gardener and Click Clack Moo, Cows that Type during our reading sessions.

UTW - Geography

The children will be exploring natural objects and flowers and will be exploring signs of Spring. We will be learning about different types of weather and will be learning about the four seasons and seasonal changes between each season.



PSHE
