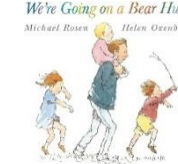
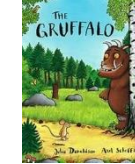
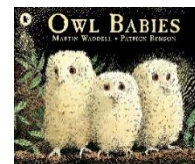


EYFS Newsletter Autumn 1



ENGLISH

This term the children will focus on learning how to independently write their name and will learn single sounds through their Phonics lessons. They will learn how to form these sounds and will also take part in word time sessions and begin to learn to write simple words.



MATHS

Compare groups of objects
Sorting in different ways
Explore repeating patterns
Compare size, length and weight of objects.

UTW - RE

This term the children will be learning about different celebrations. We will be discussing how we celebrate birthdays and will be learning about the celebration of Diwali.



UTW - SCIENCE

Animals – The children will be learning about living and non-living things and will be learning about various woodland animals.

Materials – The children will be learning about how materials change through melting and freezing.



COMMUNICATION & LANGUAGE

The children will be introduced to a broad range of vocabulary and will be learning through various stories. We will be focusing on the texts: The Something, Owl Babies, Stick Man, The Gruffalo and We're Going on a Bear Hunt.

UTW - Geography

The children will be exploring maps this half term. We will be building maps of their classroom and the school and will be learning to recognise features and symbols of a map.



PSHE

The children will be talking about the special people in their lives and will be discussing similarities and differences between themselves and others. They will be learning about different emotions and will be learning how to identify and manage their feelings.



Music

The children will be exploring a range of songs and musical instruments. They will explore making sound with their voice and with percussion instruments to create different feelings and moods and will be practicing finding the beat of a song using actions.



Art & DT

This term the children will be using different materials to draw and make marks. They will explore materials such as pencils, felt tip pens, wax crayons, chalk and paint and will explore observational drawing. The children will develop their scissor and cutting skills and will learn how to join materials together.



PE

Children will be introduced to PE through the topic of 'everyday life' and will learn basic skills including using space, using and sharing equipment and working individually and as a group. They will also learn fundamental movement skills such as running, jumping and skipping.
