

Year 2 Newsletter Autumn I

ENGLISH

This term the children will be learning to write a fictional narrative based on the book "A River" by Marc Martin. We will be focussing on conjunctions to join sentences e.g. "and, or, but, so. Using adjectives and verbs to add details and using the correct punctuation.



MATHS

This term we will be studying place value. They will be learning to understand the value of 2 digit numbers. They will learn to compare and order them. The children will count in 2's, 5's and 10's. Then they will be learning to find 10 more and 10 less.

SCIENCE – Animals Including Humans.

This term we will be learning about the growth of animals, including humans. The children will learn to understand animals' basic needs and how they adapt and survive by ensuring their basic needs are met.

History- **How Was School Different in the Past?** We will be making comparisons between schools in the past and present, using sources to research and understand what schools were like 100 years ago. We will arrange and date photographs in a chronological order to observe change over the years.

The children will learn about the importance of staying safe whilst using online devices.
