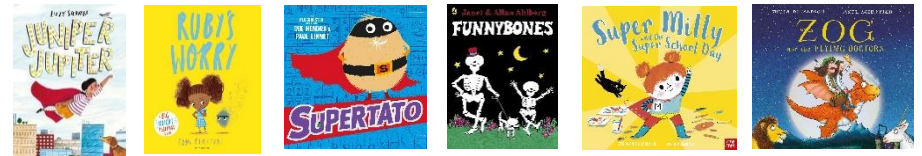


EYFS Newsletter Spring 1



ENGLISH



This term the children will continue to focus on building independence when writing. They will continue to develop their Phonics knowledge and be learning to blend to read words and read simple sentences. They will be working on using their Phonics skills to write CVC words and simple captions.

Music



The children will be exploring tempo and pulse by listening to music and showing the beat with actions. They will be using percussion instruments to explore sounds and play along to the music.

UTW - RE

This term the children will be exploring where they belong and will be discussing what is special about where they belong. We will be discussing families, how we belong to our school and class, our community and any other groups the children may belong to.

UTW - SCIENCE



This half term the children will be learning about their body. We will be naming and labelling parts of the body and will be discussing what we can do with different parts of the body. The children will be learning how to keep their bodies strong and healthy and will be learning about healthy and unhealthy foods.

COMMUNICATION & LANGUAGE



The children will be introduced to a broad range of vocabulary and will be learning through various stories. We will be focusing on the texts: Juniper Jupiter, Rubys Worry, Supertato, Funny Bones, Super Milly and the Super School Day and Zog and the Flying Doctors as well as using non-fiction books to learn about people who help us.

Maths

This term the children will be continuing to build their fluency working with numbers up to 5. We will be focusing on subitising, composition of numbers and how to represent numbers. The children will also begin to learn about the numbers 6, 7 and 8 as well as exploring mass and capacity.

PE



In this unit children will develop basic gymnastic skills through the topic of traditional tales. Children will explore creating shapes, balances, jumps and rolls. They will begin to develop an awareness of space and how to use it safely.

PSHE



The children will be learning about how to keep themselves safe this half term. They will be learning how to stay safe at home and at school as well as staying safe online. They will also be talking about the adults in their lives and community that can help to keep them safe.

UTW - History



The children will learning what the word past and present mean and will be exploring their memories and experiences from their past. We will be exploring changes over time and will be exploring how they change as they grow up and be able to recognise the order that events happen.

Art & DT

This term the children will be exploring mixed media and collage in their art lessons. We will be exploring transient art and will be learning about the artist Megan Coyle and will be creating our own landscape collages. In our DT lessons we will be preparing and making our own vegetable soup, linking to our Science lessons.
