

Year 2 Newsletter Spring 2



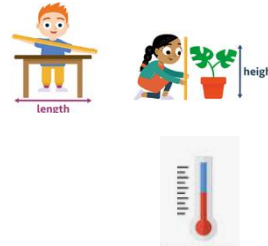
ENGLISH

We will be writing an exciting diary entry based on the story Flower Block by Lanisha Butterfield.

Later on in the term, the children will be writing a narrative memory based on the book Grandad's Camper by Harry Woodgate.

MATHS

This term's units will be:
Length and height
Capacity and temperature.



SCIENCE – This term in science we are going to be exploring 'Animals, including humans – Life cycles' we will take the children through lessons where they are taught how to notice that animals, including humans, have offspring which grow into adults



Geography – Why is our world wonderful?

The children will learn to identify and locate characteristics of the UK on a map. They will also identify human and physical features. They will learn to explain the differences between oceans and seas, name and locate the five oceans on a world map.

COMPUTING – Programming – Robot algorithms

Children will be learning to understand instructions in sequences and the use of logical reasoning to predict outcomes.



PSHE

This term in PSHE we will be focussing rights and responsibilities. We will be exploring the risks of being online and how we can stay safe online. The children will learn about how we can get on well with others in the classroom as well as consider how to manage impulsive behaviours.



RE



This term in Religious Education we will be looking at how people celebrate different festivals around the world. We will be thinking about why festivals are important to people. The festivals we will be learning about are Easter, Passover, Eid Ul Fitr, and

Art

We will be learning to use and explore paint and mixed media. Encouraging pupils to experiment with materials and evaluate their artistic choices. This term's lessons aim to develop children's understanding of colour, texture, and composition in art.



PE – Gymnastics

The children will explore and develop basic gymnastic actions on the floor and using apparatus. They develop gymnastic skills of jumping, rolling, balancing and travelling individually and in combination to create short sequences and movement phases.



Music – Travel

In music we will be focusing on the theme of travel. We will be exploring musical storytelling and imagine that we are travelling by river and by train.
