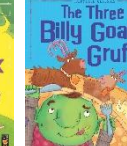
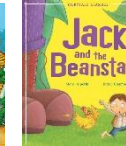


# EYFS Newsletter Spring 2



## ENGLISH



This term the children will continue to focus on building independence and confidence when writing. They will continue to develop their Phonics knowledge and be learning to blend to read words and read simple sentences and be practicing reading words more speedily. They will be working on using their Phonics skills to write simple phrases and sentences and will be using these skills to write instructions linked to our story Little Red.

## Music



The children will be exploring pitch and will be exploring appropriate hand actions to show different pitch. They will also explore making up new lyrics and thinking of accompanying actions to match a song.

## UTW - RE



This term the children will be learning about looking after special objects and will be learning about special books for different religions. They will explore different bible stories and discuss what makes them special and will be discussing meanings behind stories.

## UTW - SCIENCE



This half term the children will be learning about their senses. The children will look at the different senses and how they interact with one another, and what our senses enable us to do. They will be using our senses to explore materials around them, the children will use different vocabulary to describe different materials.

## COMMUNICATION & LANGUAGE



The children will be introduced to a broad range of vocabulary and will be learning through various stories. We will be focusing on the texts: Little Red, Billy and the Dragon, Little Red Riding Hood, Jack and the Beanstalk, Zog, The Three Billy Goats Gruff and The Gingerbread Man. We will be learning to retell stories using songs and actions.

## Maths



This term the children will be learning about numbers up to 10 and will be focussing on different representations and composition of these numbers. We will be learning number bonds to 10 and will also be exploring length and height.

## UTW - History



The children will be exploring the past through characters and events and compare characters from stories and discuss past and present. They will also be learning about generations and will be creating their own family tree and show understanding of where to place each member of their family.

## PE



In this unit children will develop their expressive movement through the topic of 'places' They will explore how to use space safely and will explore travelling, actions, shapes and balances. They will use counting to keep in time with the music and perform their ideas to others.

## PSHE



The children will be learning about rights and respect. They will be learning about how to care for their home, school and special people and will talk about how they can make an impact on the natural world. The children will discuss similarities and differences and will demonstrate building good relationships with friends.

## Art & DT

This term the children will be developing their threading skills and will be creating an image using different materials. They will draw and plan out a design for a bookmark and will use needle and thread to create their design. The children will also reflect on what they have made and discuss what they like and what they could make even better.
