

Year 1 Newsletter: Summer 2

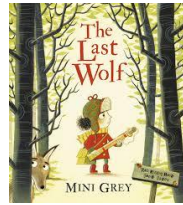
Welcome back to our next and final term in Year 1. Please find below the contents of our curriculum this term.

ENGLISH- The Last Wolf

The children will be writing:

- Hunting Story
- Recipe



MATHS



The children will be learning the following:

- Place value within 100
- Fractions
- Money



SCIENCE - Seasonal changes

The children will learn:

- The 4 seasons
- Changes that take place in each season
- Weather and how seasons change



History- How have toys changed?

The children will learn:

- What their favourite toy is
- Whether parents and grandparents played with the same toys
- What toys were like in the past
- How teddies have changed over time
- How toys have changed



COMPUTING - Introduction to animation

Using ScratchJr, the children will explore sprites, backgrounds, and coding blocks to create projects.

The children will be learning:

- What Bible stories tell Christians about God
- How Jews show that the Torah is special
