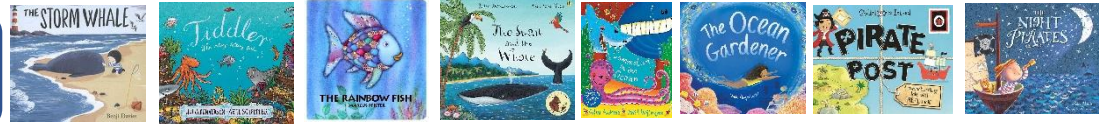


EYFS Newsletter Summer 2



ENGLISH



This term the children will continue to focus on building independence when writing and adding more description to their sentences. They will also be thinking about the correct letter formation and size. They will continue to develop their Phonics knowledge and be learning to blend to read words and read simple sentences, practicing reading words more speedily. They will also be using these skills to write a poem about a whale.

Music



The children will be singing and playing a variety of instruments using call and response songs. After this they will be composing our own songs by changing the words.

UTW - RE



The children will be learning that people have different beliefs about the world and its creation. We will also be thinking about how we take care of our world and respond to 'I wonder@ questions.

UTW - SCIENCE



This half term the children will be learning about how to care for different environments focusing on the ocean. We will be thinking about the importance of keeping the ocean pollution free. We will also continue to think about the seasons of the year comparing the similarities and differences between spring and summer.

COMMUNICATION & LANGUAGE



The children will be introduced to a broad range of vocabulary and will be learning through various stories. We will be focusing on the texts: The Storm Whale, Tiddler, Rainbow Fish, The Snail and The Whale, Commotion in the Ocean, The Ocean Gardener, Pirate Post, The night Pirates, Pirates Are Coming and Pirates Wear Underwear, We will be learning to retell stories using songs and actions.

Maths



This term the children will be learning to create their own pattern rules, think about the position of an object using positional language and interpret and draw their own maps. We will also consolidate everything that we have learnt this year in Maths.

PE

In this unit children will develop the fundamental skills of PE by playing a variety of games. They will practice our school value of teamwork by playing games as a team and taking turns. By playing these games they will need to play by the rules, sometimes against an opponent.



PSHE



The children will be learning about how we grow and change. We be thinking about changes in nature and humans, naming the different stages of childhood. We will be learning the correct vocabulary when naming the different body parts and how to keep ourselves safe.

UTW – History



The children will be comparing what the seaside is like now and in the past. We will be using photos and videos and discuss what is the same and different about these times.

Art & DT



This term the children will be learning about waterproof materials. We will be designing and making our own boats using junk modelling. We will continue to develop our drawing and painting skills by using different tools safely.
